Day 1: Arrive in Brunei

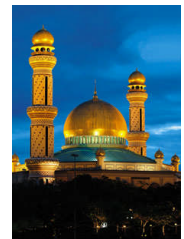

Arrival in Brunei International Airport, you will be meeting on arrival and transfer to the Orchid hotel for check in and rest for the day. Dinner at local restaurant, after dinner, proceed to visit to Jerudong Park Playground. Transfer back to hotel; overnight stay at the hotel.

Day2: Brunei City Tour

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel; proceed for Half Day City & Water Village Tour – You will be drive past the Lapau, Dewan Majlis and the Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque. Visit to the Brunei Museum, the Royal Regalia Centre. Take a boat ride on the local "Water Taxi" on the Brunei River. Visit to one of the houses built on stilts where local cakes and tea will be serving to you. Visit the Jame Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque will give an magnificent view of it. The tour will be end after making a photo stop at the Sultan's Palace – Istana Nurul Iman. Proceed for lunch at local restaurant. Transfer back to hotel; Dinner at local restaurant, overnight stay at the hotel accommodation.



Day 3: Brunei - Labuan Cement Diving

(B/L/D)

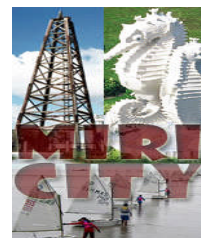
After breakfast, pick up from hotel and transfer by ferry to Labuan. Upon arrival in Labuan, transfer to hotel Sheraton and check in. Lunch will be providing at local air-conditioned restaurant. After Lunch, proceed to Cement Wreck diving at today. This wreck is situated about 21Km from the marina in Labuan. It is 105 m long modern style freighter, whose name was "TUNG HWANG". The ship seems to hit the Samarang Bank while taking cement to Brunei, badly damaging its hull. While trying to make it to Labuan for repairs, she sank on 25 September 1980. This ship is sitting upright on the bottom at 30m depth. The masts are at 8m depth, the wheelhouse is at 14m depth and the main deck at 19m depth. The way it sits makes this wreck the easiest to navigate and the best for wreck diving training. A great deal of soft and hard corals grows densely on the metal surfaces while the fish population is the best of the four wrecks. There is a school of more than 2,000 barracudas being at any times and there are schools of big groupers. After diving, transfer back to hotel and rest.



Day 4: Labuan - Brunei - Miri [Miri City Tour]

(B/L/D)

After Breakfast, meet at hotel lobby and transfer by ferry to Brunei. On arrival in Brunei, transfer by land to Miri. Upon arrival at Miri, then proceed to Miri City Tour. Tour features Malaysia 1st Oil Well (The Grand Old Lady) located at Canada Hill, the largest Taoist Temple in South East Asia, Miri City Fan, Miri Heritage Centre (handicraft & Souvenir) and visit Tamun Muhibah ~ the local farmers market that you can find various tropical fruit and vegetable. Finally enjoy your shopping at Modern and Trendy Shopping Malls. Transfer to hotel for check in and overnight.





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Day 5: Niah National Park

(B/L/D)

After Breakfast, today will depart for Niah National Park (2 ½-hour ride). Upon arrival at Park Headquarters, register & have a brief study of the park information at the information centre. Then, take a short boat to cross the river to visit Niah Museum. After visit museum, proceed on plank walk for 3KM to the caves main entrance. The walk to the cave takes about 45 minutes. The Niah Cave is famous for its edible birds nest found high up in the cave about 300ft from the ground. In the Painted Cave you are about to see the prehistoric wall drawing as well as the preserved remains of the STONE AGE PEOPLE 40,000 year old. Return journey on plank walk to Niah National Park for lunch. After Lunch, transfer back to hotel.



Day 6: Miri → Mulu (Deer Cave & Lang Cave)

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel, after breakfast, transfer to Miri Airport for flight to Mulu. Arrive Mulu Airport, transfer to Royal Mulu Resort for check in. Afternoon meet at resort lobby and transferred to Mulu National Park headquarters. Upon registration and proceed on plank walk for 3 KM to reach Deer Cave and Lang Cave. After exploring the caves, Proceed to bats observatory to observe the bats flying out of caves entrance at late evening (Only confine to fine weather). Return journey on the same plank walk to park headquarters and transfer back to resort.



Day 7: Mulu → Miri → Kuching (Wind Cave & Clearwater Cave)

Breakfast at the hotel; after that, you will be transfer by longboat to Batu Bungan – Penan Settlement, to observe the tribe lifestyle and to select handicrafts on display for sale at Penan Settlement. Continue journey by longboat to Wind Cave and Clearwater Cave. Picnic lunch at Clearwater summer huts and later on, you can enjoy swimming at Clearwater spring. Transfer to Mulu Airport for flight to Miri. After arrival at Miri will be transit to Kuching and transfer to hotel Merdeka Palace for check in and rest.



Day 8: Kuching City Tour

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel; depart for Kuching City Tour, the perfect introduction to Sarawak's historic capital, this tour includes Kuching's Chinatown, the Cat Statue (Kuching means "Cat" in Malay), the colourful Tua Pek Kong Temple, the Civic Centre Viewing Platform and the world famous Sarawak Museum. Across river, visit the unique Cat Museum, passing the magnificent State Mosque and the Astana, the former residence of the White Rajahs. Return via the golden-domed City Mosque and proceed on foot through Old Kuching, visiting the colourful Central Markets and squeezing through narrow alleyways crammed with spice dealers and textile shops. Pass by the heritage buildings of the White Rajah era, the Pavilion, the Square tower, the Court House, the Charles Brooke Monument and the Post Office. Lunch will be providing at the local air-conditioned restaurant, overnight stay the hotel.





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Day 9: Semenggoh Orang Utan Wildlife Centre & Sarawak Cultural Village (B/L/D)

After breakfast, this morning we greeted by our tour guide proceed to Semenggoh Orang Utan. Here, young Orang Utans are train to survive in the wild. These Orang Utans are either orphan or rescued form captivity. When they have sufficient skills to survive in the wild, the Orang Utans are release into the forest. During the feeding time, visitors can watch their skilful movement and to observe their behaviour and characteristics. Watching these charming and entertaining Orang Utans during feeding time is a sheer delight. Most importantly, spot their delicate nests and our experience tour guide will elaborates more of this special primate called "Wild Man Of Borneo" other animals that can be found in the sanctuary are the gibbons and honey bears. Lunch will be providing at the local air-conditioned restaurant. After lunch, continue to visit Sarawak Cultural Village, a unique award – winning living museum is a "must see" attraction if you would like to experience Sarawak's Cultural in half a day. The Sarawak Cultural Village is situating a 17-acre site at the foothill of the legendary Mount Santubong, fronting the South China Sea. The village offers an excellent opportunity to see and to explore the diversity of multi-racial cultural, lifestyle, history, tradition and architecture. There are seven fascinating houses representing every major ethnic group in Sarawak such as the Bidayuh House (known as Land Dayak), Iban House (known as Sea Dayak), Orang Ulu Longhouse, and a Penan jungle settlement, The Melanau Tall House, a Malay Town House and a Chinese Farm House. All the houses are staffed with the members of their various traditional costume and our experience guide will describe and interpret their lifestyle as well as the traditional cultural. 45 minutes extraordinary cultural show will be perform in the theatre after you have touring the village. The magnificent yet colourful costumes will make your visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village a memorable one. Transfer to resort of your choice for check-in & overnight.



Day 10: Kuching → Kota Kinabalu

(B/L)

Breakfast at the resort; enjoy the resort facilities until your departure flight to Kota Kinabalu. Upon arrival at Kota Kinabalu Airport, you will be meeting on arrival and transfer to hotel and check-in. Remain of the day at leisure, overnight stay at the Imperial hotel in Kota Kinabalu.

Day 11: Kinabalu Park

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, you will be transfer to Kota Kinabalu Park. Kinabalu Park, in the State of Sabah on the northern end of the island of Borneo, is dominating by Mount Kinabalu (4,095 m), the highest mountain between the Himalayas and New Guinea. It has a very wide range of habitats, from rich tropical lowland and hill rainforest to tropical mountain forest, sub-alpine forest and scrub on the higher elevations. It has been designate as a Centre of Plant Diversity for Southeast Asia and is exceptionally rich in species with examples of flora from the Himalayas, China, Australia, Malaysia, as well as pan-tropical flora. Along the way, photo shop at Nabalu fruits and gifts market ideal for group or family photograph with Mt Kinabalu at the backdrop. Enjoy the cool climate at Kinabalu Park and its sweeping vistas. Experience walking on a hanging bridge from tree to tree and soak in the hot springs believe to have therapeutic benefits for skin care. Lunch





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will be serving at Pine Resort or similar. Return to your hotel in Kota Kinabalu. Evening, transferred to local air-conditioned restaurant for dinner, overnight stay at your hotel.

Day 12: Sapi Islan Sun & Fun

Breakfast at the hotel, after that, transfer to Kota Kinabalu Sapi Islands. Proceed to the KK jetty for 20 minutes boat ride to Tunku Abdul Rahman Island Park. After BBQ lunch, returned to mainland and straight to your hotel. The rest of the day, free at own leisure. Evening, transferred to local restaurant for dinner, overnight stay at the hotel.
