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## **12 Days 10 Nights Borneo Wonder Special + Brunei (Min 02 pax)**

### **Day 1: Arrive in Brunei**

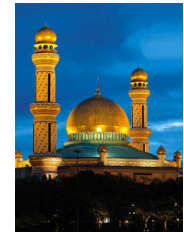
**(D)**

Arrival in Brunei International Airport, you will be meeting on arrival and transfer to the Orchid hotel for check in and rest for the day. Dinner at local restaurant, after dinner, proceed to visit to Jerudong Park Playground. Transfer back to hotel; overnight stay at the hotel.

### **Day2: Brunei City Tour**

**(B/L/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel restaurant; proceed for Half Day City & Water Village Tour – You will be drive past the Lapau, Dewan Majlis and the Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque. Visit to the Brunei Museum, the Royal Regalia Centre. Take a boat ride on the local “Water Taxi” on the Brunei River. Visit to one of the houses built on stilts where local cakes and tea will be serving to you. Visit to the Jame ASR Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque will give a magnificent view of it. The tour will be end after making a photo stop at the Sultan’s Palace – Istana Nurul Iman. Proceed for lunch at local restaurant. Transfer back to hotel; Dinner at local restaurant, Overnight stay at the hotel accommodation.



### **Day 3: Brunei - Miri**

**(B/L/D)**

After breakfast, pick up from hotel and transfer by land to Miri. On arrival in Miri, meet and greet by our friendly representative then proceed for Miri City Tour. Tour features Malaysia 1<sup>st</sup> Oil Well or The Grand Old Lady located at Canada Hill, The largest Taoist Temple in South East Asia, Miri City Fan, Miri Heritage Centre (handicraft & souvenir) and visit Tamun Muhibah ~ the local farmers market that you can find various tropical fruit and vegetable. Finally enjoy your shopping at Modern and Trendy Shopping Malls. Transfer to Park City Everly Hotel for check in and overnight.



### **Day 4: Niah National Park**

**(B/L/D)**

After breakfast, depart for Niah National Park (2 ½-hour ride). Upon arrival at Park Headquarters, register & have a brief study of the park information at the information center. Than, take a short boat to cross the river to visit Niah Museum. After visit museum, proceed on plank walk for 3 KM to the caves main entrance. The walk to the cave takes about 45 minutes. The Niah Cave is famous for its edible birds nest found high up in the cave about 300ft from the ground. In the Painted Cave you are about to see the prehistoric wall drawing as well as the preserved remains of the STONE AGE PEOPLE 40,000 year old. Return journey on plank walk to Niah National Park for lunch. After lunch, transfer back to hotel.





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### Day 5: Miri → Mulu (Deer Cave & Lang Cave)

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel, after breakfast, transfer to Miri Airport for flight to Mulu. Arrive Mulu Airport, transfer to Royal Mulu Resort for check in. Afternoon meet at resort lobby and transferred to Mulu National Park headquarters. Upon registration and proceed on plank walk for 3 KM to reach Deer Cave and Lang Cave. After exploring the caves, Proceed to bats observatory to observe the bats flying out of caves entrance at late evening (Only confine to fine weather). Return journey on the same plank walk to park headquarters and transfer back to resort.



### Day 6: Mulu → Miri → Kuching (Wind Cave & Clearwater Cave)

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel; after that, you will be transfer by longboat to Batu Bungan – Penan Settlement, to observe the tribe lifestyle and to select handicrafts on display for sale at Penan Settlement. Continue journey by longboat to Wind Cave and Clearwater Cave. Picnic lunch at Clearwater summer huts and later on you can enjoy swimming at Clearwater spring. Transfer to Mulu Airport for flight to Miri. After arrival at Miri will be transit to Kuching and transfer to hotel Merdeka Palace for check in and rest.

### Day 7: Kuching City Tour

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, depart for Kuching City Tour, the perfect introduction to Sarawak's historic capital, this tour includes Kuching's Chinatown, the Cat Statue (Kuching means "Cat" in Malay), the colorful Tua Pek Kong Chinese Temple, the Civic Centre Viewing platform and the world famous Sarawak Museum. Across river, visit the unique Cat Museum, passing the magnificent State Mosque and the Astana, the former residence of the White Rajahs. Return via the golden-domed City Mosque and proceed on foot through Old Kuching, visiting the colorful central markets and squeezing through narrow alleyways crammed with spice dealers and textile shops. Pass by the heritage buildings of the White Rajah era, the pavilion, the Square Tower, the Court House, the Charles Brooke Monument and the Post Office. Lunch will be providing at the local air-conditioned restaurant, overnight stay at the hotel in Kuching.





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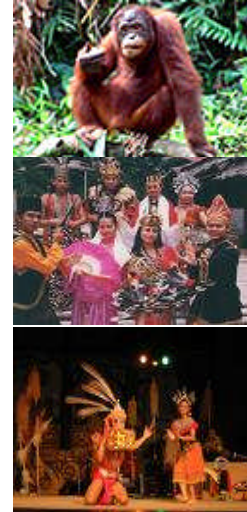
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### Day 8: Semenggoh Orang Utan Wildlife & Sarawak Cultural Village (B/L/D)

After breakfast, this morning we greeted by our tour guide proceed to Semenggoh Orang Utan.

Here, young Orang Utans are train to survive in the wild. These Orang Utans are either orphan or rescued from captivity. When they have sufficient skills to survive in the wild, the Orang Utans are release into the forest. During the feeding time, visitors can watch their skilful movement and to observe their behaviour and characteristics. Watching these charming and entertaining Orang Utans during feeding time is a sheer delight. Most importantly, spot their delicate nests and our experience tour guide will elaborates more of this special primate called "Wild Man of Borneo" other animals that can be found in the sanctuary are the gibbons and honey bears. Continue to visit Sarawak Cultural Village. A unique award – winning living museum is a "must see"

The Sarawak Cultural Village is situating on a 17-acre site at the foothill of the legendary Mount Santubong, fronting the South China Sea. There are seven fascinating houses representing every major ethnic group in Sarawak such as the Bidayuh House (known as Land Dayak), Iban House (known as Sea Dayak), Orang Ulu Longhouse, A Penan Jungle Settlement, The Melanau Tall House, A Malay Town House and A Chinese Farm House. All the houses are staffed with the members of their various traditional costume and our experience guide will describe and interpret their lifestyle as well as the traditional cultural. 45 minutes extraordinary cultural show will be perform in the theatre after you have touring the village. The magnificent yet colourful costumes will make your visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village a memorable one. Lunch is providing at local restaurant. After lunch, transfer to resort of your choice for check-in & overnight.



### Day 9: Kuching → Kota Kinabalu (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the resort, today, you will be transfer to Kuching International Airport for your departure flight to Kota Kinabalu. Upon arrival in Kota Kinabalu, meet and greet by our friendly representative and transfer to hotel and check in. Remain of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel in Kota Kinabalu.

### Day 10: Kinabalu Park (B/L/D)

It has been designate as a Centre of Plant Diversity for Southeast Asia and is exceptionally rich in species with examples of flora from the Himalayas, China, Australia, Malaysia, as well as pan-tropical flora. Along the way, photo stop at Nabalu fruits and gifts market ideal for group of family photograph with Mt Kinabalu at the backdrop. Enjoy the cool climate at Kinabalu Park and its sweeping vistas. Experience walking on a hanging bridge from tree to tree and soak in the hot springs believe to have therapeutic benefits for skin care. Lunch will be serving at Pine Resort or similar. Return to your hotel in Kota Kinabalu. Evening, transferred to local air-conditioned restaurant for dinner, overnight stay at your hotel.
